PAST PERFORMANCES:

Here are some of our standout projects that showcase our finest work.

Buffalo Creek Forest Preserve:

Created 70 acres of wetlands, added over a mile of multiuse trail, and installed a water control structure. With 5 years management and a USACE signoff.

Sugar Creek Golf Course Restoration:

Stream stabilization, construction, wetland creation, sediment & debris removal, grading, seeding, planting, & site restoration following 3 years of management. This was a 2-time award winner, American Public Works Association in the environmental category less than \$5 million and the Jane Foulser Habitat Award.

Hammel Woods Dam Modification:

Removed a low-head dam, stabilized banks, enhanced with rock, built a canoe/kayak launch, & installed native seed.

Lake Opeka Shoreline Restoration:

Features a 40-acre lake, stabilized approximately 5,500 linear feet of shoreline, & includes a 3-year landscape management plan, 7 fishing piers, 12 aquatic shelves, & 0.75 miles of asphalt trail

Forked Creek Envirolock Soil Bags:

Stabilized over 600 linear feet of streambank using various techniques, including stone toe, gabion baskets, envirolock soil bags along with native plant installation.
